

# Welcome to the park

## Enjoy, *respect* and share

This park is a shared space for everyone to enjoy, whether you're soaking up the sunshine, stretching your legs, or meeting friends for a picnic. To keep it safe, welcoming, and fair for all, we've put together a few simple do's and don'ts.

### What You *Can* Do:

- Relax and unwind – bring a picnic, enjoy your lunch, or simply lie back in the grass.
- Walk, jog, or cycle – stick to the designated paths and be mindful of others.
- Bring your dog – just keep them on a lead along walkways and under control at all times.
- Enjoy music – playing quiet, non-amplified instruments is welcome as long as it doesn't disturb others.
- Kite flying – permitted in the main park area (not Tetley Triangle), just be safe and courteous.
- Small group fitness – not-for-profit exercise classes (under 5 people) are allowed but shouldn't be a business base.

### What's *Not* Allowed:

To protect people, wildlife, the following activities are prohibited:

#### **BEHAVIOUR**

- Anti-social behaviour
- Drug and alcohol use
- Shouting, excessive noise, loud music (unless at an authorised event), or busking without permission
- Climbing trees, statues, or structures

## ACTIVITIES

- Fires, BBQs, fireworks, bonfires or releasing balloons/lanterns
- Camping or overnight stays
- Organised sports matches, cricket, golf, archery, or hard ball games
- Horse riding
- Skateboarding or cycling on the grass
- Commercial or unauthorised public performances or events
- Metal detecting, digging, or scattering ashes
- Flying of model aircraft or drones unless a formal application and license has been granted.

## VEHICLES & EQUIPMENT

- Cars, motorbikes, or e-bikes (unless dismounted)
- No self-propelled or motorised vehicles except emergency vehicles, mobility scooters and pre authorised access vehicles

## WILDLIFE & ENVIRONMENT

- Disturbing, harming, or feeding wildlife
- Damaging or removing trees, plants, or flowers
- Interfering with lifesaving equipment
